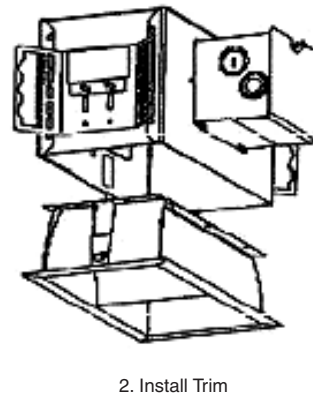
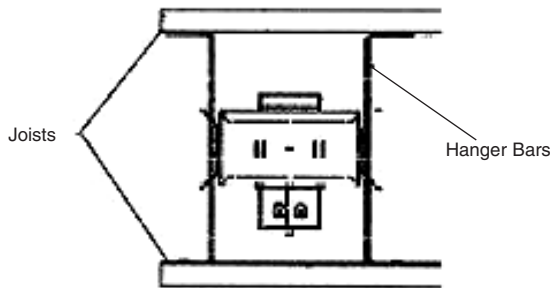
READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE INSTALLING FIXTURE.

This fixture is intended for use in accordance with national electrical codes.
Please check with your local electrical codes before installation.
To prevent electric shock terminate any electric source in the vicinity of lighting fixture.

Installation Instructions

When using electrical equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed including the following:

1. Turn off electricity at electrical panel before proceeding.
2. To prevent electric shock, for proper operation and safety, this fixture must be grounded.
3. This fixture is intended for installation in accordance with national electric code and local regulations, and by a qualified Electrician.
4. Turn off power before lamping and relamping.
5. Do not install fixture on branch circuit having a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI). Electronic ballasts may cause GFCI tripping.
6. This fixture is intended for ceiling mounting only.
7. To assure full compliance with local codes and regulations, check with your local inspector before installing.
8. Retain these instructions for maintenance reference.
9. When installing wall wash unit, make sure to install labeled end toward wall to be wall washed.
(Minor glass adjustments might be necessary when installing trim)



WARNING – (RISK OF FIRE) DO NOT INSTALL INSULATION WITHIN 3 INCHES OF FIXTURE SIDES OR WIRING COMPARTMENTS, NOR ABOVE FIXTURE IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO ENTRAP HEAT.
